HEALTH ALERT: As you are aware, **conjunctivitis** is currently spreading through our communities, we even had a few cases amongst our students recently. If your child shows any of the symptoms above now and during the mid-term break, please kindly delay them at home and seek medical intervention before allowing them to return to school.

ACADEMIC REVIEW DAY & UNIVERSITY FAIR: The Academic Review Day **ONLY** involves parents (with students) of **Years 9, 10, 11, and 12** students, and that will be on **Friday, 20th October from 8:30 am until 1:30 pm**. This information was sent out earlier by Mr. Clement Ikuyinminu.

UNIFORM PRICE INCREASE

Please be informed that due to increases in global production costs, transport, and a fickle forex exchange rate, we are compelled to increase the price of uniforms from term 2.
