UNIFORM PRICE INCREASE

Please be informed that due to increases in global production costs, transport and a fickle forex exchange rate, we are compelled to increase the price of uniforms as from term 2. The new prices will be advertised before the close of term 1. Parents are requested to follow the prescribed process for ordering uniforms, namely, complete the uniform order form (downloadable from the JHC web site, or you may request a copy from admission@jameshopecollege.edu.ng), complete payment, then send the completed form with proof of payment to the admission email address – **not** via WhatsApp. Upon receipt the uniform order will be filled, and students informed to collect.

STUDENT LOCKERS

Lockers are now available for the students to keep their extra stationery items, textbooks and notebooks. Parents are advised to purchase a **padlock slightly larger than a luggage lock**. The combination type locks have proved to be troublesome as time goes on, thus, a padlock with keys is highly recommended.
